- Founded in 1969, the Achievement Centers for Children & Families began as a pilot program in response to the overwhelming need for affordable, quality childcare available to low-income working mothers.
- Our programs provide opportunities for children to thrive and support the role of families in nurturing their development.
- The groundwork of learning and academic success begins with our 12 month old toddlers and continues through all our programs. The Achievement Centers' programs continue to achieve important successes in child and family education.





OURIMPACT

• Community Impact: Community impact is obtained through the many collaborative relationships including the United Way of Palm Beach County, Town of Palm Beach United Way, Lutheran Services of Florida, the City of Delray Beach, and working with other groups in the community to provide services that benefit the whole family.

• Impacts:

- In the toddler program 95% demonstrate good progress toward readiness skills.
- 99% of the children in afterschool programs are promoted to the next grade.
- 98% of the children graduating from ACCF's VPK Early Learning Program maintained an attendance level of at least 70%. Those students met or exceeded the kindergarten readiness.
- In the three summer camp programs, 100% of the children are engaged in structured, meaningful activities in a safe and enriching environment.

ADOPT-A-LITTLE FREE FOOD PANTRY

- As food insecurity and hunger remain an issue in the community, we always need help stocking our Little Free Food Pantry which is located on the street in front of our Early Learning Center and is available for all to take food as they need.
- How it works:
 - donations of non-perishable grocery items to be placed in the pantry
 - if the pantry is full, items can also be dropped at our Foundation office across the street
 - some adopters choose to adopt the pantry for a month, some for a week, and some who do it on a more informal and casual basis.
 - we have some local organizations and companies that organize food drives and collect a large amount of items, which is then sorted and distributed by our staff.
 - we also accept monetary donations to assist us with purchasing food for the pantry.
